

¿Adónde vas?

DUE: March 22

You will tell about your family's weekly schedule of activities.

- Download the "Thinglink" app. Choose a map as your image to work with.
- Choose pictures to place in the right places on your map and **label them with the Spanish words.**
- Write a sentence or two that tells **where** and **when (day and time)** you and others go to each place. Also include **what you and others do there.**
Be sure to use these 4 forms at least once each: voy, va, vamos, van.

There are MANY ways to write sentences that include this information. **Use a variety, not a pattern.**

EXAMPLES:

- Yo voy a la fiesta el viernes a las nueve de la noche para bailar.
 - El viernes yo bailo en la fiesta. Voy a la fiesta a las nueve de la noche.
 - Yo voy a la fiesta para bailar. Voy el viernes a las nueve de la noche.
 - El viernes a las nueve de la noche yo voy a la fiesta para bailar.
 - El viernes voy a la fiesta a las nueve de la noche . Voy para bailar con Marcos.
 - El viernes voy a la fiesta a las nueve de la noche. Bailo y canto.
- **Make a video** where you read your sentences. **One for each place.** Place the video in the correct place on the map and **write your sentence in the text box** available. (You do this while you are in "Thinglink" app.)
****Bonus points for videoing yourself on location!**
 - The the rubric I will use to grade your project is on the back of this sheet.
 - Turn your "Thinglink" map into Google Classroom and give me this rubric. (No rubric means a 5 point deduction in your grade.)

This entire project can be done on your iPad with the Thinglink app and photos from online. If you choose to go to Thinglink.com, you have more options for your icons/tags.
